#### **OVERVIEW**

The Apprentice Meter Technician will install, maintain, and test single-phase watt-hour meters, poly-phase meters, instrument transformers, and associated equipment to provide for accurate metering.

#### **ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Test and repair single phase and three phase meters
- Must be able to change routine three phase meters in field & verify the new meter
- Install three phase and single-phase transformers rated meters at new installations
- Install, maintain, and test AMR modules and related equipment.

## **QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

High school diploma or GED (General Equivalency Diploma) required. Strong mathematics aptitude required. Entry level with required completion of REC 8-step apprentice meter technician training program or equivalent.

The ideal candidate must have knowledge of the meter testing equipment, types of single-phase and three-phase meters; installation of meters and associated equipment; and developing written reports. Must have the knowledge of wiring and connections of self-contained meters. Must know how to record voltage and amperage. Must possess basic computer skills, to include a working knowledge of Microsoft Office products, including, but not limited to: Outlook, Excel, Word and PowerPoint as required by job responsibilities.

Must have the ability and skill to carry out meter testing. Must be able to work with tools to wire and repair meter equipment. Must be able to install meters, and sockets. Must possess a valid driver's license. Perform other duties as assigned.

Usual meter shop conditions. Fieldwork required to assist Meter Technicians and for assistance in outage restorations. Must be willing and able to work in all weather conditions. Occasional overtime may be required. Occasional overnight travel may be required for training.
