## MANAGING YOUR ENERGY USE IN WINTER

Winter still hits hard in Virginia – especially for power bills.

Here are five energy-saving tips to help you keep in the heat and manage your bills during the coldest months of the year:

### Use less hot water:

Adjust the temperature setting on your water heater to 120 degrees.

### Don't block your heat supply:

Make sure that return air vents aren't blocked by furniture or other objects.

### Let the sun in:

Opening your curtains and drapes on sunny days, especially for south-facing windows, can give your home some free heat.

### Spare fridge or freezer:

If not kept full, it should be emptied and unplugged until needed.

### Get more predictability:

Sign up for budget billing for predictable monthly payments throughout the year. This can really help if your energy bills are significantly higher in the winter.

### Winter Safety Tip: Downed Power Lines



In the winter months, ice can bring down power lines in Virginia. Always assume a downed line is energized and stay at least 35 feet away from the line or anything that may be in contact with it. Also, never drive over a downed power line.
