

Assistance Among Other Electric Cooperatives and Utilities in Emergencies

Policy #: BP 32

Rappahannock Electric Cooperative

1. Purpose

To define the guidelines through which Rappahannock Electric Cooperative (REC) may provide assistance to or receive assistance from other electric cooperatives or utilities in accordance with customary mutual aid arrangements and reimbursement practices.

2. Scope

This policy applies to REC and its personnel and equipment.

3. Policy Statement and Implementation

3.1. REC may assist other cooperatives and utilities during emergencies.

3.2. REC may receive assistance from other cooperatives and utilities during emergencies.

3.3. Assistance should be coordinated through the Virginia, Maryland, and Delaware Association of Electric Cooperatives (VMDAEC) when possible.

4. Responsibilities

The Board of Directors delegates the authority to carry out administration of this policy to the President & Chief Executive Officer.

5. Confidentiality

This Policy may be treated as public and may be made available on REC's website or other communication channels.

6. Definitions

Emergencies: Events requiring resources and/or an organized response beyond the capabilities of one organization.
